This can be explained by two aspects. First of all, the main educators of a child in a family are the father and mother. If they fail to teach the child the correct views on gender, if they are



given incorrect information, the child will accept those ideas that were first told to him as the most correct. For example, a father tells his son: “You are a boy, you are stronger than your sisters, they should respect you and do what you say. “If they don't do what you say, you have to punish them,” then the best solution for the child is to make women respect men even when he becomes an adult. Therefore, in order to instill in children the principle of gender equality from an early age, it is necessary to instill this principle in their parents. In other words, the teacher himself must be educated. Secondly, personal example in family education is one of the main means of influence. If a father tells his son that “a man should always respect women,” but he himself has a bad relationship with his wife, the child will most likely grow up with this attitude towards women. In other words, it's not for nothing that a bird does what it sees in its nest.

## **Results**

Restoring family values and strengthening family ties in the new Uzbekistan, economic, cultural, spiritual, means professional development. The family and family problems have always been under the protection of the state, and this issue is the fundamental law of the Republic. - change the negative ideas formed in society about the role of women and men in family relationships, support propaganda work in this direction with the participation of the media;
- increasing the responsibility and role of men along with women in the comprehensive intellectual, moral, aesthetic and physical development of children, taking into account advanced foreign experience;



- further improvement of the system of counseling women and men on problems of family life, psychological, pedagogical, legal and other issues;
- protect families from delusions based on the idea of superiority of one sex, which lead to violations of the moral principles of young people, deny family values, promote immorality, and also create disrespectful attitudes towards parents and other family members;
- increase the effectiveness of information and educational activities about the rights, freedoms and responsibilities of women and men in family relationships.
